Payments and Fee Schedule AS OF SEPTEMBER 1, 2016

Registration Fee for new, modified, or relocated equipment and renewals.

\$ 200.00 Plus GST Registration Fee for each piece of equipment – once every four years

\$ 80.00 Plus GST Administration Fee once every four years (NOT PER PIECE OF EQUIPMENT)

\$ 80.00 Plus GST Administration Fee charged if equipment is relocated within the first two years of the four year cycle and an inspection is required. A new certificate will be issued with original expiration date.
